Job Description

1. Ambassador will work collectively, cohesively, and closely with Ambassador Coordinator, Site Manager, and other Sacred Waters Team Members to execute a seamless event.
2. Ambassador will help participants to manage basic daily needs etc.
3. Ambassador must be willing to work as a team, take instruction, guidance positive reinforcement from Management.
4. Ambassador will ensure participants that are assigned to their dorm have welcome packets, goodie bags, maps, programs, schedule, resource information, bed linen etc.
5. Ambassador must be able to effectively communicate, practice self-care, be flexible and attentive to all details & be a compassionate team player.
6. Ambassador must have a great attitude, be highly cordial, and possess a desire to serve.
7. Ambassador must check your email daily and respond to retreat emails within 24 hours of receiving, be available for monthly/weekly conference calls and other virtual platforms for meetings.
