Ambassador will work collectively, cohesively, and closely with Ambassador Coordinator, Site Manager, and other Sacred Waters Team Members to execute a seamless event. 2. Ambassador will be selected based on geographical locations around the United States, their current work in or amongst community-based organizations especially those involving women of color, passion for the Sacred Waters Retreat and its programs. 3. Ambassador will ensure participants that are assigned to their rooms have welcome packets, goodie bags, maps, programs, schedule, resource information, etc. 4. Ambassador will check in with participants to ensure they are getting through each day with ease. 5. Ambassador will also be responsible for the set -up, upkeep and take down of sacred spaces. 6. Ambassador will may be assigned to manage & hold space during workshops etc. 7. Ambassador should be highly cordial, know how to speak and communicate with staff & participants. 8. Be willing & capable of advertising the retreat through various social media venues, groups etc. You will have access to various pre-approved postings provided through our social media department. 9. Ambassador must be willing to work as a team, take instruction, guidance positive reinforcement from senior staff & elder council. 10. Ambassador must be able to effectively communicate, practice self-care, be flexible and attentive to all details & be a compassionate team player. 11. Ambassador must have a great attitude, be highly cordial, and possess a desire to serve.
